HOW TO APPLY

A complete scholarship application has two parts:

1. Submit the online application.
 - To begin, go to <https://micf.org/scholarships/>
 - Click on “Apply for a Scholarship,”
 - Follow the provided Scholarship Portal Instructions to begin.
 - Click “register a new account.”
 - Register as an Individual
 - Create your account and write down the email and password.
2. If you are dual-enrolled or a current college student, request your official college transcript be sent to the Foundation. The Foundation will work with your guidance counselor to receive a copy of your high school transcript.

TIPS AND TRICKS

- You can save and edit your work at any time. **SAVE** often!
- **Do NOT use your high school email address!**
- Write activities/employment/volunteering and essay in a word document first.
- Have someone proofread! A teacher, advisor/counselor, community member, parents, etc.
- Make sure to answer the actual questions.
- Be clear, avoid acronyms.
- List all high school and community involvements, even if only active for one year or one time.
- Save essays! They can be used on multiple applications often with a few tweaks.
- Include all work experiences.
- You will find out if you received a scholarship in May and you will be recognized at the high school awards ceremony. Non-traditional students will be notified by mail in May.

Essay Question

- Include a personal essay telling us about you, your educational goals, where you see yourself in 10 years, your goals in life including those you have achieved as well as those you still wish to achieve and other pertinent information about yourself. *Your response is limited to 4,500 characters.*
